

Due at the October 2, 2019 meeting:

Simple Four-Patch Pincushion

Finishes at 4 inches square

For bottom of pincushion:

Cut a 4 ½ inch square of fabric

Pieced top, 4 patch:

4 different fabrics or 2 each of 2 fabrics

Cut each 2 ½ inch squares

Batting:

Warm and Natural or other flat batting or a layer of flannel

Cut 2 pieces at 4 ½ inches square

Stuffing:

Crushed walnut shells

Directions

1. Piece the 4-patch. Spin the center seam to reduce bulk.
2. Layer pieced top with batting.
3. Quilt the top.
4. Layer solid bottom with batting.
5. Quilt the bottom.
6. With right sides of top and bottom together, stitch ¼ inch seam all around leaving 1 ½ inch opening on one side.
7. Turn right side out.
8. Stuff with crushed walnut shells. Optional: use rice, sand, or polyfil
9. Plug hole with scrap or polyfil and hand stitch closed.
