

Chicken: paper-pieced log cabin 5 inch square

Separate page... add 1/4 inch to outside of paper pieced diagram before piecing. Makes a 4 1/2 finished square.

Chicken: traditionally-pieced log cabin 5.5 inch square

5 inch square divide by 5, note this method makes a 5.5 inch square, just for the ease of doing the math! Finishes at 5 inches square.

Cutting and piecing directions for each side

Cut 1 red and 1 light square 1.5 inch sq...twice

Cut 1 light and 1 dark rectangle 1.5 x 2.5...twice

Cut 1 light and 1 dark rectangle 1.5 x 3.5...twice

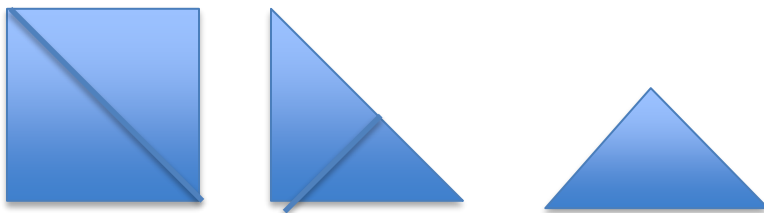
Cut 1 light and one dark rectangle 1.5 x 4.5...twice

Cut 1 dark rectangle 1.5 x 5.5...twice

Also cutting diagram for cutting and placement of beak, comb and tail

Beak...yellow cut 1 1/2 inch square fold diagonally twice.

Comb...red cut 3 squares each 1 1/2 inches and also fold twice diagonally

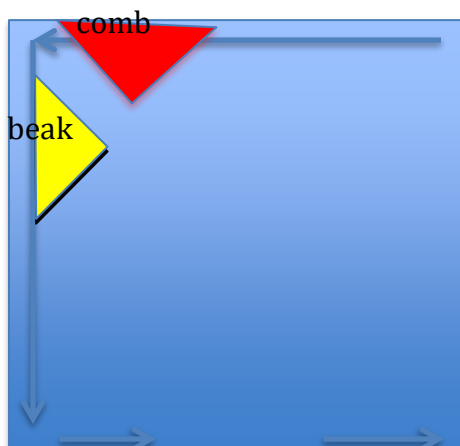


Tail...any color cut 1-3

squares at 3 inches and fold in half the long way and then each point at fold to the bottom center.



Sewing, 3 sides leave opening in one side. Leave tail side unsewn.



Do not sew this side at all! Pull open and insert tail pointing in.



Seam



Leave opening in bottom for stuffing
