### Folded Origami Hexi Star

#### Supplies:

Fabric approx., 9 inch square

Needle

Matching thread

1 or 2 buttons

6-8 inch long piece of narrow ribbon

Printed 8 inch hexi template/pattern

Step 1: I starched and ironed my fabric to give it some body.

Step 2: Cut out fabric hexi using printed template.

Step 3: Mark center of hexi and center of each side, with pen or pencil.

Step 4: Make the first stitch through center of hexi on the wrong side of the fabric. This will make sure knot is on the inside of the finished star.

Step 5: Take a stitch at the center of one side and bring it to the center and finish stitch.

Step 6-10: Repeat this process going around the edge of the hexi. Lifting the point in between each stitch.

Step 11: Knot thread but leave attached.

Step 12: I finger pressed down the outer edge and ironed it.

Step 13: Pull up one point and open it, finger press it down with point touching center of hexi. While holding it down at the halfway point, bend the point back to outer edge to form a diamond, and finger press, then fold the point back to center and take a stitch.

Step 14-18: Repeat this going around hexi.

Step 19: Knot the thread and sew on button/s.

Step 20: Attach a hanging ribbon.

This can be used as an ornament. A bow on a package! In place of a yo-yo on a quilt for a flower or star applique!
