

Use English Paper Piecing and fussy-cutting to create a medallion which can be sewn onto a bag, clothing, or made into a quilt. Below you will find links to help you and to provide inspiration!

Hexies, diamonds, triangles... You can make a simple Grandmother's Flower Garden flower with seven hexagons, a Patchwork of the Cross block, a Brimfield block (What is that?!?)- whatever design you choose. Google English Paper Piecing for ideas, and see sample ideas under the Creative QuiltWorks area of the Newsletter page on our website.

What you need:

- Card stock for EPP shapes, or buy ready-made shapes at a quilt shop
- Fabric...something different, amazing, awesome, out of your box!

Directions:

1. Cut out card stock in shape of pieces you are going to use: hexagons, jewel shapes, etc. (See sample shapes in the links on the website.)
2. Fussy cut fabric pieces 1/4 inch larger than card stock cutouts.
3. Glue or thread tack fabric over cardboard.
4. Arrange and whip stitch together.
5. Appliqué to whatever you like!
