

May 2021 Creative Quiltworks Dress Form pincushion

Requirements:

1 Fat quarter fabric
Scraps of trim, ribbon, lace, beads and bling
polyfil or other stuffing material
cardboard scrap
craft glue

Directions:

Cut out 2 fabric dress form pieces.
Cut out 1 large fabric oval.
Cut out 2 small cardboard ovals.
Sew dress form together using $\frac{1}{4}$ inch seam allowance, leaving bottom edge open.
Fold up bottom edge $\frac{1}{4}$ inch and baste.
Glue 2 cardboard ovals together.
Glue fabric oval to one side of cardboard ovals and up around them.
Fill dress form with polyfil until cardboard just fits in opening, insert cardboard and hand stitch around fabric covering to basted edge of dress. Remove basting stitches.
Embellish!!!

Attach to base:

Glue directly to base or if base has a peg or stem, make hole in fabric-covered cardboard the same size and glue hole onto peg.
I used a candlestick that had a screw on it when I removed the candle cup.
