

Snow Trees

Fabric:

2 1/2" strips of green, white, and sky-blue fabrics

Cutting:

White:

One 4 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangle for snow on top section of tree

Green:

One 6 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangle

One 8 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangle

One 10 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangle

One 12 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangle

One 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" square (trunk)

Blue:

Two 6 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles

Two 5 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles

Two 4 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles

Two 3 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles

Two 2 1/2" squares

Two 5 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles (for either side of trunk)

Sewing instructions:

Tree Branches:

Lay a background strip atop the white or green rectangles as shown in drawing below. The first blue pieces listed go with the white top of the tree, the next blue pieces listed go with the first green piece listed, and so on down the lists.

Draw a line from corner to corner.

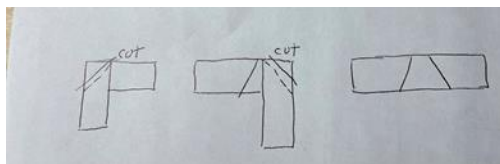
Sew on the drawn line.

Trim off corner leaving 1/4".

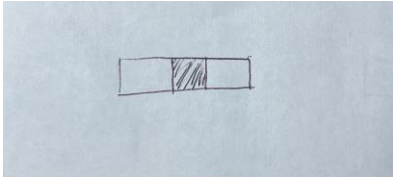
Press.

Press.

Repeat on the other side.



Tree trunk:



Sew 5 1/2" background rectangles to each side of 2 1/2" green square.

Sew branches and trunk together. Press.

Block size 12 1/2" unfinished.
