

Requests from Kristin for readying your quilt for Long Arm Quilting:

No pins, cut all threads, press all seam allowances of the blocks to dark side.

Batting: Pocking side up (fuzzy side down.)

Add 4" plus to top, bottom and both sides when preparing back side.

Sew 1/8" in from edges to keep the seams from opening up on the front, especially if you have piano edges.

Cut selvage off or cut it every inch so it won't bind.

Back should have 90 degree on all four corners and have equal sides.

Use fusible webbing on both sides of batting to join batting if not using zig-zag stitch to join pieces together.

If you are using triangles on the edge, capture the bias in the center of the triangle.

Mark the tops of the front, batting, and back with a paper marked TOP and pin it in the middle of all three pieces.
